

***Citizens Bank Minnesota* Medallion Hunt – Official Rules**

August 10 – October 2, 2026

1. General Participation & Safety

Participation in the *Citizens Bank Minnesota* Medallion Hunt (“Contest”) is voluntary and undertaken **at the participant’s own risk**. All participants must comply with all **local, state, and federal laws**, including but not limited to park rules, posted hours, and no-destruction policies.

Participants are solely responsible for their own safety, especially when participating after dark. *Citizens* assumes **no responsibility or liability** for injuries, accidents, property damage, losses, or expenses of any kind resulting from participation in the Contest or acceptance of any prize.

2. Medallion Placement Rules

- Medallions will **not** be hidden on private property.
- Medallions will **not** be hidden in areas that require digging, dismantling, or destruction of public or private property.
- Participants **must not damage parkland or property**, including but not limited to:
 - Pulling down or breaking branches or trees
 - Removing bricks, stones, mulch, or landscaping
 - Damaging signage, structures, or fixtures

Any participant causing damage may be disqualified and may be responsible for restitution.

3. Eligibility

- The Contest is open to individuals **13 years of age or older** at the time of participation.
- Employees of *Citizens* and their immediate family members (spouse, children, and household members) are **not eligible** to participate.
- No purchase is necessary to participate or win.
- Participants do **not** need to be a client of *Citizens*.

4. Clues & Contest Timeline

- Clues will be posted **daily**:
 - Online (*Citizens* digital platforms), and
 - Inside *Citizens* branch locations during regular business hours.
- The **first clue** of each hunt week will be released on **Monday at 9:00 a.m.**
- If a medallion is **not found by the time the following Monday's first clue is posted**, the prize money for that medallion will be **donated to a local non-profit organization** selected by *Citizens*.

5. Finding a Medallion & Claiming a Prize

Once a medallion is found:

1. The finder **must immediately notify *Citizens*** by:
 - Email: **marketing@citizensmn.bank**, or
 - Phone: **1-800-549-0194**
2. The finder will be required to **describe the exact location** where the medallion was found.
3. The medallion must be **physically brought to the *Citizens* branch nearest to where it was found** in order to claim the prize.

Failure to follow these steps may result in disqualification.

6. Winner Announcement & Publicity

- Winners will be announced **as soon as *Citizens* is notified and the find is verified.**
- By accepting a prize, winners grant *Citizens* permission to use their **name, image, and/or photograph** for promotional and publicity purposes without additional compensation, unless prohibited by law.

7. Prizes & Locations

Medallion quantities by branch:

- **New Ulm:** 8 total medallions
- **Lafayette:** 2 total medallions
- **La Salle:** 2 total medallions
- **Ormsby:** 2 total medallions

- **Lakeville:** 4 total medallions
- **Watkins:** 4 total medallions
- Each medallion is valued at **\$150**.
- **Limit one (1) medallion prize per household** for the duration of the Contest.

8. Taxes

All prizes are subject to applicable federal, state, and local taxes. Prize winners will be issued a **Form 1099** at year-end. Winners are solely responsible for any tax obligations associated with prize acceptance.

9. Conduct & Disqualification

Citizens reserves the right to:

- Disqualify any participant who engages in misconduct, cheating, tampering, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Interpret and enforce all Contest rules at its sole discretion.

All decisions made by *Citizens* regarding the Contest are **final and binding**.
